Number of Players: 2 per Team; Players work in tandem

Objective: To make a bed to mirror "H-Games Bed" specs, but faster than your competitors.

Course Set-Up: Start/Finish line; queen size bed set: frame, box spring and mattress; teams will place linens, that they have brought with them in a central location.

Rules:

1. Players to begin at the starting line. Upon signal, clock starts as players race to linen table and work together to assemble bed according to H-Games Bed specs. See attached form.
2. Please see specs and penalties on SAMPLE SCORE SHEET. The Judges will review the bed making process and note what they are looking for prior to the start of competition.
3. When the players feel their bed is MADE TO PERFECTION, they tap the bed and step away, then the judging begins.
4. The Judges will take their time and review each criterion on the score sheet and score accordingly where any penalties were made. Initial time and penalty time will be added together to give you the overall team time. Best times will be awarded highest number of points in succession.

NOTE: Each team is required to bring their linens and have each piece folded separately. See the attached score sheet for required linens. A false start will cause the team to start over. A 6 MINUTE MAXIMUM INITIAL TIME WILL BE CALLED. At that time, players will need to step away. Judging will then begin and any unfinished parts of making the bed will be subject to penalty scoring criteria.

Basic Steps for Bed making

AR Hospitality Bed Spec's for 2018

- 1) Put the Fitted sheet on the bed. If not using fitted then tuck corners of a flat sheet**
 - 2) Put the First flat sheet on the bed and make sure that your sheet is flush to the head board**
 - 3) Place the blanket onto the bed, with the top about 3 inches from the head board**
 - 4) Put the next sheet onto the blanket to match the top**
 - 5) Fold down the first sheet to make a 3 inch fold at the top of the bed**
 - 6) Fold the bottom corners into a hospital bed type, this includes bedspreads or duvets**
 - 7) Tuck in both sides of the bed fully and tightly, this includes bedspreads or duvets**
 - 8) Add the pillow cases and pillows to the bed, making sure they are perky**
 - 9) Make sure the bed is very tight and clean cut looking**
